Exhibition dates: June 11 to August 23, 2026

Galería La Sindicalista, based in Cáceres, is pleased to invite artists from all over the world to participate in “CLÍO”, a group exhibition dedicated to the Greek muse of History and memory. This exhibition constitutes the second chapter of our annual series devoted to celebrating the muses through contemporary art.

In this edition, **15 original works** inspired by Clio and her vast symbolic territory will be selected: personal history, collective history, invented chronicles, memory, remembrance, as well as political, social, or historical critique. The open call invites artists to explore not only the past, but also the ways in which we narrate it, interpret it, and transform it.

All selected works will be available for sale, and **one of them will be acquired** to become part of the gallery’s permanent collection. This work will join those awarded in the **1st Open Call held in 2025**, with the intention of organizing one call each year until completing the cycle of the **nine muses**.

Introduction

First, let us try to resolve all questions, doubts, and procedures. It is not complicated, but it is always better to be well informed.

Terms and Conditions

1. Who can participate?

- Artists over **18 years of age**, of any nationality, working in **any discipline**. Please note that if your work is sold, you must be legally able to issue an invoice.

2. Theme

- The works must be inspired by **CLÍO**, addressing themes such as **history, memory, remembrance, critique**, your own personal history, or an invented one. You may also develop a **theoretical framework** that you are able to link to the concept of the exhibition through your artwork.

3. Format and technique

- Works in any medium are accepted (**painting, sculpture, drawing, illustration, photography, collage, digital art, printmaking, etc.**).
- **Maximum size:** 50 × 50 cm. Exceptions may be considered depending on the type of work or format, such as freestanding sculpture or video art.

4. Sale of works

- The selected pieces will be **for sale during the exhibition**, with a **35% commission** for the gallery.

How to Participate

The following elements will be taken into account when evaluating proposals:

1. A **high-quality image** of the work (or a sketch if it is still in development).
2. **Technical sheet:** title, technique, dimensions, and year of creation.
3. A **short text** (maximum **200 words**) explaining how your work connects with **CLÍO**.
4. An **artist biography or CV** (maximum **200 words**).

Selection

- A specialized jury will select the **15 works** that best represent the theme of **CLÍO**. Selected artists will be notified starting **May 4, 2025**.

Important: please take deadlines into account.

Delivery of works

- Selected pieces must be delivered or shipped to **Galería La Sindicalista** by **May 27, 2026**.

Collection of works

- Works that have not been sold or acquired for the collection must be collected or shipped back between **August 25 and August 31, 2025**.

Size and Technique

- **Maximum size:** 50 × 50 cm.
- All techniques are accepted: painting, sculpture, drawing, photography, digital art, printmaking, illustration, etc.

Image Rights

- By participating, you authorize the use of images of your work for the **promotion of the exhibition**.

Sale of Works

- The gallery will apply a **35% commission** on each sale.

Important notice: Digital works created using **artificial intelligence techniques** will be reviewed, and all works that are **entirely produced using such tools** will be disqualified.

Additional Information

Special Prize

- One artwork will be **acquired (purchased)** by La Sindicalista for its **permanent collection**.

Visibility

- Exhibition at **La Sindicalista** before a diverse audience, increasing your artistic visibility.

Sales Opportunities

- All pieces will be available for sale during the exhibition. **80% of the works exhibited were sold** in the **1st Open Call held in 2025**.
